14. <u>Discuss and consider banking agreement for District accounts</u>; After some discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Newstrom and seconded by Commissioner Schwartz to accept the bank rates from Prosperity Bank – Elgin #161 as follows. Regular checking account – 0.20% interest rate

Money market account – 0.35% interest rate.

Motion passed unanimously.

- 15. <u>Discuss and consider a policy on visitors to District stations</u>; A motion was made by Commissioner Newstrom and seconded by Commissioner Schwartz to add to the Employee Handbook and Standard Operation Guild lines (S.O.G's) that visitation hours will be from 8:00a.m. to 8:00p.m. at both District stations. Anything after those hours must be approved by the chief, president or FR1 Coordinator. Motion passed unanimously.
- 16. <u>Discuss and consider filling vacancy in the First Responder program</u>; Commissioner Newstrom reported that he was working with Chris from the FR1 program to get the vacancy filled as soon as possible.
- 17. <u>Discuss and consider repair and maintenance of the District's facilities and equipment;</u> Commissioner Newstrom reported that a new generator had been ordered for the McDade Fire Station. Chief Reyna reported that Engine 2 had to be put in the shop for some transmission problems.
- 18. <u>Discuss agenda, time and date for next meeting.</u> A motion was made by Commissioner Schwartz and seconded by Commissioner Newstrom for the next regular meeting to be held on December 15, 2020 at 6:30P.M. at the Elgin Fire Station and/or Zoom video conferencing app. Motion passed unanimously.
